PASS offers programs and services for young people aged 14 - 21 with an IEP or 504 plan

For ongoing support, Vocational Rehabilitation (GVRA) encourages students and young adults to enroll as many times as you wish in Transition services. This supports continuous growth in reaching employment goals and unlocking endless opportunities!

Work-Readiness Training This comprehensive course provides tools and knowledge focused on building successful careers. Work Readiness assists with: Employment Goals, Professionalism, Accomodations, Resources, Resumes, Interview Prep, Work Skills, and Financial Literacy, among others.

Self-Advocacy Training A course designed to empower for post-high school life, eduation, and professional careers. Self-awarenss, Self-determination, Rights & Responsibilities, and Leadership are explored.

G.R.O.W. This course is a weeklong experiential program that provides additional training and support in Self-Advocacy, Career Exploration, Workplace Readiness, Counseling on Post-Secondary Opportunities, and Work Based Learning Experiences. Provided during school breaks.

Project SEARCH An internationally recognized program that creates a highly effective school-to-work bridge. Students participate in three 10-week internships at the host business site, explore job interests, and gain professional skills that lead to bigger and better career opportunities. Offered as a student's last year of high school.

Individual Job Placement Services Through the assistance of a job coach, job seekers are supported in finding and building desired career pathways. The job coach and job seeker work side-by-side through career development, career negotiation, accommo dations, training, and more

Supported Employment/Customized Employment Work one-on-one with a Job Coach to develop a career plan, set goals and expectations, create a resume, practice interviewing, search and apply for jobs and train on how to navigate the workforce. Once you begin work, on site job support is available.
